

CerTest 5.0 Computer-Based Testing Program Update for the Fire Protection and Readiness Flights, December 2007

This update:

- Incorporates the prior March 2005, June 2005, and July 2006 updates.
- Updates CerTest to Version 5.3
- Deletes six obsolete tests.
- Renames several tests so they are better organized and family grouped by category.
- Adds the *Web-Based Certification Courses* Training Area.
- Adds ten new Web-Based course tests.
- Revises test bank questions that were revised based on valid question challenges.

Downloading and Copying Instructions

1. Go to the following web site:
http://www.CerTest.com/Download/CerTest_December_2007_Update.zip
2. Save the zip file to your computer or choose "Open" and extract the files to your computer.
3. If you save the zip file to your computer, unzip the folder and extract the file names below to your computer.
CerTest_December_2007.tst, CerTest_December_2007.txt and CerTest_Update_5_3.exe
4. **Extremely Important:** The first thing you need to do is double click on the CerTest_Update_5_3.exe executable and update CerTest to Version 5.3.
5. The next step is to Start the CerTest Program and make sure the CerTest log on screen has Version 5.3 located in the bottom right-hand corner of the screen. Once you confirm you have Version 5.3 loaded, Log in as a Manager.
6. Click on the "File" option located in the upper left corner of the screen.
7. From the File menu, select the "Copy From Diskette" option (The 7th Option).
 - a. A "Copy From" screen will appear.
 - b. Make sure the file folder where you extracted the files to is selected in the "Look in" box and that the "Files of Type" box at the bottom is changed to "Test."
 - c. Click on the CerTest_December_2007.tst file you saved earlier.

- d. Now click on the open button to start the update process. When the updates are complete a "copy test(s) into CerTest" screen will appear.
 - e. Highlight all tests available in the menu.
 - f. Click on the copy button.
 - g. Another dialog box will appear labeled "Replace Test?" Click on the "Yes to All" option.
8. After a few minutes, CerTest will respond with a message telling you the number of tests that were successfully copied. Select OK in the Copy Complete information box and you're done.

Reminder: You must complete this task on each computer that has the CerTest program loaded on it unless you are running CerTest on a Network.
